

Fred Lynch Memorial Award

Fred Lynch of Dartmouth was an individual who brought an abundance of energy, skill, determination, and class to Nova Scotia sports. He will be remembered fondly for his tremendous contributions as a builder in canoeing and hockey.

Lynch gained his first taste of acclaim in 1961 when he coached a Dartmouth-based women's war canoe team to a North American title. He was successful himself in capturing the Canadian Junior K1 and K2 titles in 1965. He was also the founding father and executive of Canoe Nova Scotia, the Nova Scotia Provincial Instructors School, and the Coaches Association (Atlantic Division).



Fred passed away in 1982 and was inducted into the Nova Scotia Sport Hall of Fame in 1985.
