

Nova Scotia Waterways Stewardship Award

This award is given annually, at the discretion of the Canoe Kayak Nova Scotia (CKNS) board of directors, at the CKNS annual general meeting. Recipients of the award need not be members of CKNS.

It is presented to an individual (or an organization) in recognition of a high degree of initiative and commitment in working towards the preservation of our province's waterways.

The award may be given for a specific project or activity designed to improve water quality or the health of aquatic ecosystems; or to preserve and enhance public access to our waterways; or to maintain portages, waterway access points, beaches, and campsites.

The deadline for receipt of nominations for the Nova Scotia Waterways Stewardship Award is one month before the annual general meeting.
